Please read the festival's regulation below:

Non-Competitive International Participants:


1. All performers and musicians should be Zoroastrian.
2. The educator or conductor could be non-Zoroastrian.
 - 2.1. If the Conductor is Zoroastrian, they could be a member of musicians.
3. For participating in this year's festival, please register on www.jashnvaremoosighi.kdz.ir . The registration is open from November 6th to November 13th.
4. The deadline for sending your videos is November 20th. Please send your videos after your registration to @kdz_id on Telegram.

Performance Duration:

Solo Performers:

1. For traditional percussion instruments (tombak, Daf, ...) maximum of 10 minutes.
2. For traditional string instruments (Tar, Santoor, Setar,...) maximum of 14 minutes.
3. For classical instruments in any genre, a maximum of 15 minutes.



Ensembles and Duets:

1. For ensembles of percussion instruments, maximum of 16 minutes.
2. For ensembles of traditional Iranian instruments, maximum of 20 minutes.
3. For duets, maximum of 16 minutes.

Note: Due to the Islamic Republic laws, the hijab is necessary for 12 years above.

Note: Please hold the camera horizontally for recording and ensure both the instrument and performer are seen clearly.
